Job Description

Village Baptist is looking to fill a pastoral vacancy within the church. This role is defined by pastoral leadership, where ministry is conducted through the establishment, development and leadership of ministry teams.

Position Overview

The Associate Pastor will work directly with the Lead Pastor, staff, and ministry leaders to implement the ministry vision and core values of the church. Their primary responsibilities will be youth ministry and supporting the activities of our community trust. Their secondary responsibilities include supporting other areas of church life such as preaching and outreach events.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Youth Leadership:

To pastorally lead and disciple youth through a wider youth ministry team. This involves:

- Leadership Development: growing, developing, and supporting a youth ministry team through which the youth will be discipled and led.
- Youth Discipleship: facilitate a weekly discipleship program and connect with the families of the youth for the purpose of supporting their discipleship.
- Youth Fellowship: facilitate a regular youth social program that fosters relationships amongst the youth, and a positive culture that is reflective of the church.
- Camps and events: Attend youth and youth leadership camps (e.g. Easter Camp, Xtend, KB Weekend), taking youth and youth leaders where appropriate.

Community Outreach:

To support the leadership of our Community Trust (Te Waa) to grow our outreach into the community, alongside supporting existing community ministries.

Preaching

To participate in the regular preaching life of the church, as frequently as once a quarter.

Church Events

To support other staff and ministry leaders in the running of core church outreach events (e.g. Light Party, Easter Egg-stra).
